Our summer school options are varied and structured to meet different needs at different locations; some are academic while others are enrichment-based. If you are interested in exploring the options, talk with a counselor or teacher at your school to find out if they will have any summer programming at your school.

For high school students, summer school will be at the locations below.

- Open to all Jeffco high school students; mainly for those who need to recover or complete credits.
- Follows a blended format, with varying options for face-to-face support.
- Students will need to access a computer and the internet daily, and complete work from a home setting.
- Courses are set up in a mastery format (*exception at bottom) where pretesting determines amount of content to be learned. Students move through designated coursework at their own pace.
