
# 12th grade ICAP/College Info Meetings:



## From Food & Nutrition Services:

We received the news that the USDA has extended waivers making it possible for all students, across the district, to receive meals **at no cost regardless of their free and reduced meal eligibility!** This will provide increased access to school meals and give us more flexibility in how we serve these meals. Please spread this message to your community.

## **Waiver Talking Points**

- USDA Waivers have been extended giving **free meals to all students in the district** regardless of free and reduced eligibility!
- Waivers extended through December 31, 2020
- It is **essential** that families still complete a Free and Reduced Meal Application
- Free meals applies for all types of learners in-person, hybrid, and 100% remote
- Parents and Guardians may pick up meals for remote learners
- Student accounts will still be used to purchase a la carte items

With this change, we are able to expand the number of sites for 100% Remote Learners to receive meals. **Beginning September 14th**, meals for remote learners will be available at their home sites or convenient location (ie; siblings meals can be picked up at one location). We hope this will allow for more students to access these meals. For the week of September 8th, remote and hybrid learners may continue to receive meals at the 8 Remote locations.

## 100% Remote Learners

- Meals will be distributed Tuesdays and Thursdays in a timeframe between 2:30 3:30 pm.
- All children 18 and under may receive meals during these distribution times.
- Children will receive multiple meals at a time.
  - o Tuesday: 2 Lunches and 2 Breakfasts (if school normally serves breakfast)
  - o Thursday: 3 Lunches and 3 Breakfasts (if school normally serves breakfast)
- Meals will be distributed at an outside location in front of school
- Parents and Guardians may pick up meals for remote learners.

# **Hybrid Remote Learning Days**

- 3 days' worth of breakfast and/or lunch meals for remote learning days will be provided at the end of school day on the second day of in-person learning for each student each week.
- Meals can be taken home with students.
- Students will pick up these meals in the cafeteria or at another location(s) designated by school and take them home.
