

Dakota Ridge High School Remote Learning Plan

Dakota Ridge High School will implement a virtual model starting on Tuesday, March 17th. The majority of our students in our classes are already familiar with online learning platforms (Google Classroom, Schoology) inside the classroom, so they will be able to navigate their lessons. If students are unfamiliar with the specific class online platforms, they should email specific teachers by Monday, March 16th.

First, you should know that class can operate virtually using applications and devices already available to your student with any internet connection or their smartphone. Here are the free applications for download::

- Google Classroom, Docs, Drive, Meets, Chat
- Schoology
- Edgenuity (Credit Recovery)

On DAY 1 (March 16) of school closure, your student's teachers will be preparing for online learning across the closed locations.

On DAY 2 (March 17th - Cardinal Day) of school closure (through its end), your student's day will look like this:

- Attendance: Students will be expected to log in and complete an attendance form for each block each day. Students must complete the form for each block by 5:00 PM each day. If a student is a TA for the block, please complete the attendance form. Students in Study Hall do not need to complete the attendance form.
- Assignments: Teachers will communicate through their usual online platform (Google Classroom, Schoology, email) coursework, essential skills, resources, and due dates per class block (Navy blocks on Navy days).
