

Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update: Technology and School Closure - 3/13/2020

Good Evening Dakota Ridge High School Families;

Jeffco School families received an email from Jeffco Schools regarding the closing of all school facilities for in-person classes next week, 3/16 through 3/20. In response to the school closure, we have created a Remote Learning Implementation Plan to support student learning. Additional details will be communicated to the school community via our website and email.

A key component to delivering content during a possible closure will require students to be able to access curriculum digitally. The technology tools used to support learning in an on-line environment closely mirror those tools currently being used by teachers and students.

No students or staff will be allowed access to the school campus to retrieve any personal belongings beginning Tuesday, March 17. Students should plan on bringing their school provided device and chargers home after school today, March 13.

For senior students only who do not have access to a computer (e.g. Chromebook, PC, Macbook, phone, etc.) at home, a limited supply of Chromebooks will be made available to check out from our Library. Due to the limited supply, Chromebooks are available only for students that do not have access to a device at home. These Chromebooks can be checked out from the DRHS Library today during 8th block and immediately after school. Students will be supplied with a Chromebook device and charger. They will be responsible for proper care of the device and returning it once the school closure has been lifted.

Please know that Dakota Ridge High School continues to be committed to providing the best possible education to our students, while also being mindful of the health and well-being of our community.

In the coming days and weeks, please continue to read updates. While we know that there will be much more to communicate during the school closure, being prepared with technology will support the learning of your student(s) within a remote learning environment.
