

# CREDIT RECOVERY OPTIONS- Summer 2019

## **1. JEFFCO VIRTUAL ACADEMY ONLINE**

Summer School: Online Summer School Registration opens on May 1, 2019

Please ask your DRHS counselor to submit an Online Counselor Verification Form after you register for the class. Students will also need to complete an Intro to JVA tutorial as part of the enrollment process.

Students participate in an initial assessment to determine their understanding of a subject. The classes are administered entirely online through Jeffco Schoology and Edgenuity.

Cost: \$165 per class. No refunds. Students are allowed to take up to 2 Online Summer School courses per summer.

Note: *Jeffco Virtual Academy credit recovery online courses are NOT APPROVED for NCAA athletic eligibility purposes.*

## **2. SUMMER SCHOOL THRU COLUMBINE HIGH SCHOOL**

Dates: May 30th through June 21st. Monday - Thursday from 8-11 am.

Students must attend Orientation on May 30th from 8:00 am- 10:30 am.

Students are limited to 2 credit recovery classes through CHS summer school.

Cost: \$165 per .5 credit class.

Registration can be made online. Click here for online registration.

*Student must be logged into her/his jeffcoschools.us account to access the Registration form*

You may make payment (Cash or Visa/MC only) in person at your home high school prior to May 24th, or at Columbine HS anytime during regular school hours. Registration is not complete without payment.

The last days to make payments at Columbine are May 24th and May 28th from 8 am through noon.

Students should consult with their HS counselor to verify the needed credit recovery class(es).

Attendance Policy: Due to the short length of the summer session, students who are absent from orientation and/or class for more than ONE day will be dropped from the program without credit (three tardy marks will count as one absence.) No refunds.

## **3. BRIGHAM YOUNG UNIVERSITY ONLINE <https://is.byu.edu/catalog> -or- #1-800-914-8931.**

When: Throughout the year. When all BYU assignments are complete, you must notify BYU of your DRHS counselor's name and school address to have them send the final exam to us. All BYU correspondence final exams should be proctored at DRHS – there is NO proctoring available during the summer. Once registered, students have one calendar year to finish the course. Seniors needing a BYU class to graduate must complete the class assignments and have the final exam to DRHS by May 1<sup>st</sup> in order to ensure enough time to get the exam back to BYU for grading and graduation purposes.

Registration: Online or via telephone. Please obtain counselor pre-approval to make sure you register for the correct class **(you must enter the DRHS school code "060923" during the registration process for proper placement in the class).**

Cost: Approx. \$156 per .5 credit course.

Credit: These classes are for high school credit recovery only and will appear on your DRHS transcript. Not for college credit.

Note: Jeffco students may take a maximum of 2.0 "non-Jeffco" credits (four .5 credit courses) towards a diploma. BYU online classes are considered "non-Jeffco." BYU online courses are NOT APPROVED for NCAA athletic eligibility purposes.

## **4. SOUTH AREA ONLINE CREDIT RECOVERY PROGRAM @ DRHS**

**AVAILABLE FALL AND SPRING SEMESTERS ONLY!**

Registration: First come, first serve- limited seats available. Students must discuss program details with DRHS school counselor prior to enrolling in any online credit recovery class. The last day to add an online credit recovery class is the 12<sup>th</sup> week of the semester.

Students may take a maximum of two classes per semester. Attendance policy & behavior expectations will be in effect for all classes.

Contact: High School Counselor

When: Each semester, within the academic school day. 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students: This online credit recovery class will replace your Study Hall class. 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade students: This online credit recovery class will replace an off block if short on credits-counselor will determine this by looking at transcript.

Where: Dakota Ridge High School, working in computer lab directly with a DRHS staff member during an assigned block of time, unless approved to work on outside of scheduled school day.

Cost: This program is available during the school day, and thus free of charge.

## **5. COMMUNITY SERVICE (for ELECTIVE credit only)**

What: Community service is defined as "non-paid, non-court-mandated, volunteer service for a non-profit organization." A family member may not be the supervisor to sign off on the hours.

Credit: A student will earn .25 elective credit for 45 hours of volunteer service, .50 elective credit for 90 hours. **A maximum of 1.00 elective credit of community service may be applied toward graduation requirements.**

Community Service will go on the transcript as Pass/Fail elective credit only.

Pre-Approval: In order to be assured credit, a student must fill out the Pre-Approval Form in the Counseling Office and have his or her counselor sign it before beginning his/her hours.

Requirements: Students must submit a log of completed hours and a 1-page paper about their experience to his/her counselor to receive credit.

**NOTE: Students may not use any of these options to count for "credit advancement. "They are for "credit recovery" only.**
